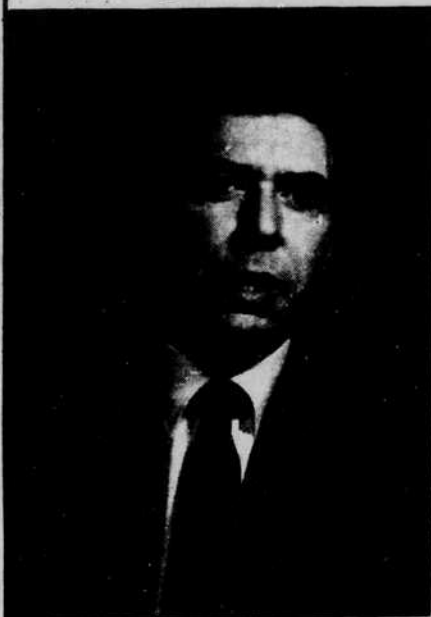


Stan's the Man for Governor!

EOB withdraws application

Economic Opportunity Board officials have notified the Regional Transportation Commission they intend to withdraw their application for funds to build and operate their own maintenance facility for senior citizen buses.

However, the EOB's other application for \$24,000 in matching grand monies to help them acquire new buses will be heard at a public hearing on EOB requests in the RTC meeting at 8:30 a.m. Thursday in the Council Chambers at North Las Vegas City Hall.

Other matters to come before the commission include the establishment of an area-wide committee to study the possible routes for access to Husite, the 25,000 undeveloped acres Summa Corp intends to turn into a new city northeast of Las Vegas.
