IRS RECRUITING VITA VOLUNTEERS

RENO — Volunteers are needed to help others with their tax returns as part of VITA, the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program sponsored by the Internal Revenue Service.

The IRS said that VITA programs are sponsored by local civil or fraternal organizations, educational institutions, churches and social groups. These groups help to set up VITA sites and provide volunteers.

Most VITA sites operate in local neighborhoods at schools, churches and libraries.

REAGANOMICS WIDENS GAP BETWEEN THE RICH AND POOR

In a 530 page study titled "The Reagan Experiment" issued by the Urban Institute it was concluded that President Reagan's policies are widening the gap between the country's rich and poor. According to the Wall Street Journal, this is the most extensive research on the subject so far.

The study proves that Mr. Reagan is achieving the biggest change in U.S. domestic policies since the New Deal. This is in keeping with Reagan's pre-election promises. However, the consequences promise to be painful for poorer regions and poor people. While the Reagan-

backed tax cuts for middle-income and wealthy individuals combined with cuts in social programs for the poor could mean that the administration's policy changes might result in a healthier economy by 1984, it is clear that most low-income households will be far worse off than in 1980.

The study was made possible by a \$3 million grant from the Ford Foundation and a \$1 million grant from the MacArthur Foundation.

The Urban Institute is a nonprofit organization based in Washington and was founded in 1968 to study economic and social problems related to government policy.
