

Tax Planning Seminar To Be Held In Phoenix

"Successful Tax Planning for the Family and Its Business" is the topic of the Phoenix Tax Workshop/Arizona Tax Institute's annual seminar, to be held Saturday, November 20, 1982 at the Phoenix Hilton, Central and Adams Streets, Phoenix, Arizona, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The program will include such topics as: 1982 Tax Developments Affecting the Independent Business Person, the Self-employed Professional, and the Investor.

How to use Partnerships for Family Income and Estate Tax Planning, covering such items as shifting income

from a high to a low bracket, how to freeze values for estate taxes and how to pass on future growth largely tax-free.

How to Use Trusts in Family Income and Estate Planning, covering such items as "Clifford Trust" vs. "interest free loans" in saving for college and how to use the "crummy power" in an Irrevocable Trust in order to keep the \$10,000 annual exclusion.

The afternoon session of the program will cover How to Use the New Pension Rules to Accomplish Your Tax Plans. Included in the discussion will be: What impact the new law will have for the existing corporation's plan. Do you really need to incorporate? Should you use contract staffing? How to deal with the new "top-heavy" rules. Should you allow your pension plan to own real estate and how to get a specific exemption to "self deal with your retirement plan."

Speakers include prominent Phoenix C.P.A.s and tax attorneys who specialize in income tax planning. The program is aimed at attorneys, C.P.A.s, bankers, estate planners, business owners and their advisers.

The Phoenix Tax Workshop was originally founded in 1960 under the sponsorship of the University of Arizona. It became an independent non-profit organization in 1974. Over the years it has sponsored many programs on successful tax planning. The program on "Successful Tax Planning for the Family and Its Business" has been approved by the State Board of Accountancy for continuing education credit for C.P.A.s.
