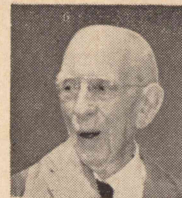

# OBSERVATIONS

### THE REAL LAS VEGAS

**T**HE idea, held by some casual  
observers, that Las Vegas is  
a city of roisterous drunkards  
and crooked gamblers, is about as far  
from the truth as is possible to get.

Las Vegas, since its birth as a  
growing community when the railroad  
company auctioned off its town lots,  
has been just as sober and quiet as any  
other growing town in the United  
States — actually more quiet and  
orderly than many others!

Before Las Vegas became a town,  
religion was one of its inmost charac-  
teristics. In fact, in 1855, Missionaries

of the Church of Latter Day Saints,  
sent out from Salt Lake City by Brig-  
ham Young, founded the Mission of  
Las Vegas in the face of adverse con-  
ditions which would have discouraged  
less determined souls, and that church  
now has several beautiful buildings  
and many thousands of devout fol-  
lowers here.

Before the townsite was opened,  
the Methodists were holding services  
regularly in the tent school-house on  
the side of the creek. Under the  
leadership of Dr. Bain, a very devout  
old gentleman, these services were  
attended by persons of all denomina-  
tions.

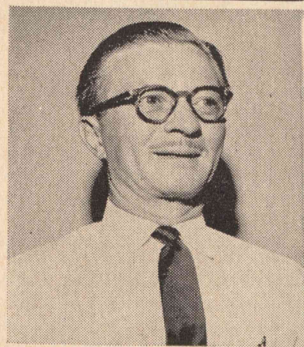

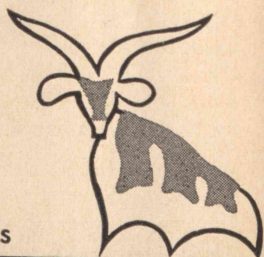

**C**ONSTRUCTION of a four and one half million dollar Convention Hall and expansion of other facilities in the resort and tourist fields in Southern Nevada is scheduled to begin in October, to keep pace with increased tourist travel in FLV. Scheduled to be completed by the Fall of 1958, the new Convention Hall is designed to accommodate all types of sales meetings and conventions, with a seating capacity of 9,500 delegates and 129,000 square feet of exhibit space. With the bonds already sold, bids on the \$4,500,000 structure will be opened October 3rd, with construction to follow. . . .

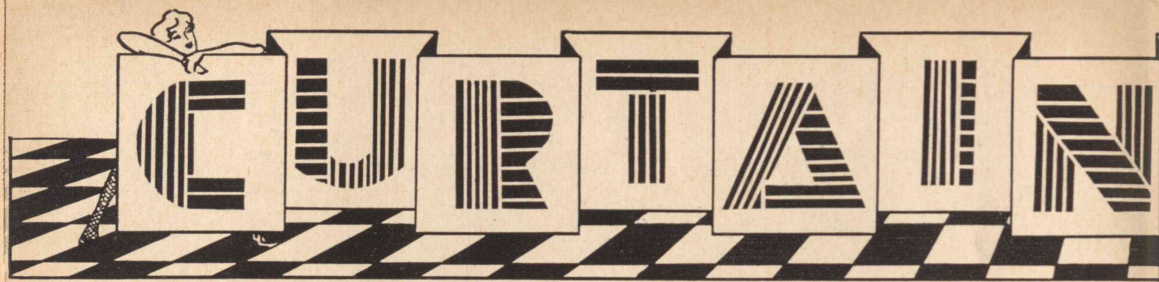

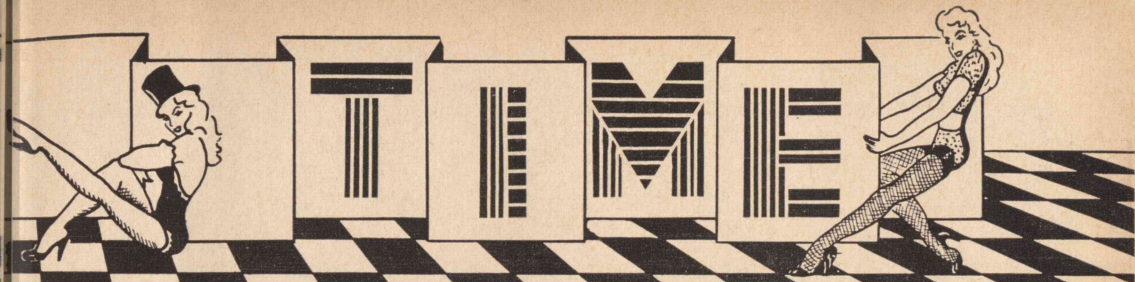

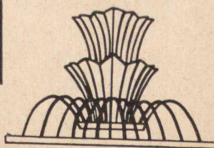
