After the sale of lots, in spite of the half dozen saloons, the people earnestly took up the work of building an orderly, law abiding town and several church organizations were established. Among these were the Christ Church, Episcopal, under the leadership of its young Rector, Harry Gray. It was under his guidance that the first church building in Las Vegas, one that stood for more than forty years at the corner of Second and Carson, was built. This building was torn down about four years ago to make way for a parking lot and a beautiful new church was erected on Maryland Parkway. This edifice is soon to be enlarged.

The Roman Catholic Church entered early into the field, and there are now about eight fine structures attended by thousands of their devoted followers. The people of the Jewish faith have erected not only a church, but also a center where a great deal of charitable work is done, and they also conduct a school for young children whose mothers are compelled to work. Today there are more than fifty recognized denominations holding services regularly.

The Methodists are credited with building the second church in town, at the corner of Third and Bridger. This church was burned in 1910, but was immediately rebuilt. The list of

churches holding regular services in Las Vegas is much too long to publish here, but I am sure that no other small town can show a greater number. However, churches are not the only thing that recommend Las Vegas.

Fraternal organizations became a leading influence on September 15, 1905, when a leading citizen of that greatest of all mining camps, Virginia City, came to Las Vegas and instituted Lodge 1215, Fraternal Order of Eagles. Benevolent societies have played an important part in the development of Las Vegas and the Eagles, formed so soon after the town was born, were for a long time a motivating force in all social and civic movements. Now this lodge owns a valuable piece of property in the heart of the city.

The Masons were not instituted until 1907, owing to some distrust on the part of the Grand Lodge as to the permanence of Las Vegas. It has been active all these years and now owns, in addition to its fine Masonic Temple, a fine piece of business property valued at more than a million dollars.

Now, what about illegal gambling in Nevada? I will tell you a little about that. It was along about 1914 that there were games operating day and night in all the saloons. These games were run by known "crooks" and "card sharps" and local people kept pretty well clear of them. The few visitors from the outside were often lured by the call to "try their luck" and would yield to temptation. They were soon victimized and lost their money. If they protested they were often beaten up and thrown out into the alley where our "Big Sheriff", Sam Gay, would pick them up and take them to jail and then load them onto the first freight train out of town.

The citizens of Las Vegas soon got very tired of this, and started gathering evidence against the sheriff. Malfeasance in office, I think, was the charge that was eventually pressed. We had a District Attorney who could not be intimidated, and in May the case came to trial before a jury and Sam Gay, the seemingly invincible sheriff, was convicted and thrown out of office. J. Warren Woodard, a fine young businessman was appointed sheriff in his place.

The people of the town had gained

a great victory, or so they thought. But there was an election coming up in November and to our astonishment Sam Gay was re-elected sheriff, and he maintained his political dominance of that office until 1925!

In the meantime, the question of legalized, controlled gambling had been brought before the legislature and was finally carried. The law was far from perfect, but it has been improved by each succeeding legislature, until now it is very effective. No concern which, upon investigation, is financed in whole, or in part, by known gangsters can receive a license. On the other hand, those concerns properly financed and operated receive the support of the state.

This has been very profitable to the state in taxes and to the people of Nevada in creating jobs. As far as the casinos are concerned, licenses are too valuable to be treated carelessly, and the house "take" of a game is confined to a known and established percentage. As yet Nevada is the only state in the Union that has had the courage, and the integrity, to license gambling. The people of Nevada are orderly and law abiding and have not, ever, abused this privilege or trust.

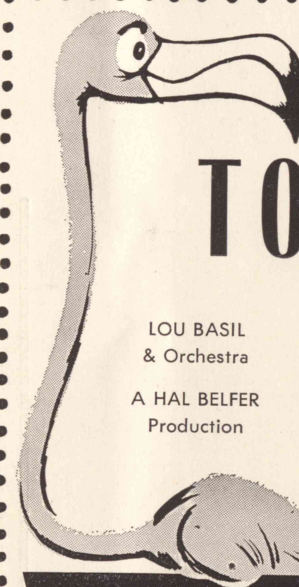
