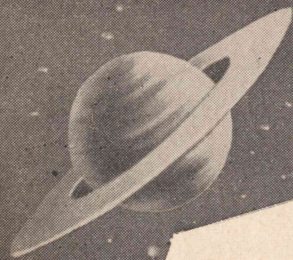

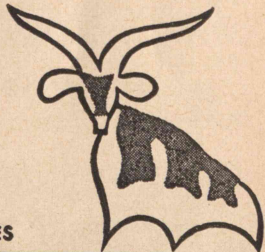

SAN FRANCISCO: First stop for anyone in show-business in this city is Al William's Papagayo Room. Saw George Gobel who just wound up an engagement at the Fairmont, feasting on Al's wondrous Mexican Burritos, Enchiladas and tacos with refritos and tortillas. And the Weire Brothers were on hand doing the same.

(Nostalgic note — Remembering Lou Costello and Bud Abbott taking me there for supper after their show at the Club Bimbo and all of us sitting and talking. Al told us of his heritage and about his Mexican mother who fell in love with his American father when he was fighting with Pancho Villa.)

In China Town is Sam Wo's where the Chinese themselves eat. A meat block and stove with singing Chinamen chopping and cutting meats and vegetables is the scene you see coming through the front door, but you are then ushered upstairs to tables to be served and entertained by Edsel Fung who is quite a character. "Psst!" he says, "you want doughnut?" Zing, you get doughnut. "Psst!" he says, "you want very fine duck soup, Chinese chow me'n, raw fish salad and egg tea?" Zing, you get it—on a take it or like it basis — and it is delicious. Mr. Fung's antics are worth an admission price — what fun. Don't ask for Mr. Wo — because "Sam Wo" means "Three In Peace" — three partners, and Mr. Fung, we gathered, is the son of Partner No. 3.

Gypsy Buyes is one of the colorful women of San Francisco. She came to Hollywood some years back and bought Rudolph Valentino's Falcon's Lair. And there she gave parties — and handed out hundred dollar bills to the actors-without-present-engagements, like she owned a printing press

that made them. In San Francisco at Elizabeth Arden's party, Gypsy told Miss Arden, "Gypsy Yuana, who used to work for me, long ago predicted your future when you were very poor and discouraged in Denver, Colorado. She said try once more." Miss Arden did. Gypsy Buyes still owns two lots, part of the original Falcon's Lair (Doris Duke bought the house and garden) and is going to build herself a Gypsy Nest on one.

Donald Maloof, the handsome young singing star once with the Arthur Godfrey television show in New York, is in San Francisco appearing in light opera — but also he is singing for free in the night clubs. Everywhere he goes they ask him to sing, and like in the movies, he gets up and sings and has all of San Francisco at his feet.

At the Bocce Ball he sang "Mada-Mina" and "Some Enchanted Evening," and the bravos and cheers rang out into the street. The head waiter said, "Hundreds of people crowd in here every night on the chance that Mr. Maloof will happen in and we can get him to sing." Singing for the love of singing shows real love for his art. He's a young Ezio Pinza.

When we paid the meter tickings, Armando smiled and said: "Well, you've ruined my whole day."

If 48832 thinks he helped our day by setting off chain reaction thinking about the Dahl-i Lamas, he's off his ten cents tax, fifteen cents tip rocker.

Suds Muddle: "A Raisin in the Sun" is a walloping hunk of good stage drama and a highly satisfying evening for any discerning theatregoer, but there's a slight commercial boo-boo in the presentation that disturbed this self styled meticulous brand watcher. In the second act the script calls for Sidney Poitier to open and drink a can of beer. No argument with that. Many a household is "foam (not so) sweet foam." However, inasmuch as the play is set in Chicago's South Side, we spotted the goof. Poitier was sipping Schaefer brew (can visible from

the sixth row) and that ain't right. A poor Windy City colored family wouldn't be stocked up with Schaefer. Unless, of course, the brood had connections in Harlem and had the Schaefer blend of hops, etc., sent out to the shores of Lake Michigan. Schaefer, the Brooklyn beer, you take it, is not sold in Chicago and you're right. We called Frank Love, property man of "A Raisin in the Sun," and checked it out. He laughed at our fact finding and admitted the error. His explanation was simple. When the show opened in New Haven and Philadelphia, the Schaefer people sent cases of beer to the theatres and Love used the cans. When the show played Chicago, a local brewery, Weisberger, sent their product over and it was used. Love has lugged some Schaefer sudsy satisfaction to the Middle West metropolis and ended up giving it to the stage hands, who admitted that they preferred the lager from across the Gowanus Canal to their own home team brand.

The story has one late addition, which rights the illogical geography: As of last week, Rheingold, a national product, is alternating nightly with Schaefer on stage at the Ethel Barrymore Theatre.
