Biographical Note

A longtime resident of Las Vegas, Nevada, Bob Stoldal has been widely recognized as a local newsman and historian. In 1967, he was hired at KLAS-TV as a news anchor and reporter, where he was promoted to News Director in 1968. He retired from KLAS-TV Channel 8 in 2008, and decided to dedicate his time to the distribution of historical information and interpretation in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Stoldal is Chairman of the Board for the Nevada State Museum and Historical Society as well as the City of Las Vegas Historical Preservation Commission. He also serves on the Nevada State Commission on Cultural Affairs, the Board of Preserve Nevada, and the Board of Directors of the

Mob Museum. Stoldal has collected thousands of postcards from the history of the City of Las Vegas, in addition to ephemera from local hotels and casinos such as the Moulin Rouge. Stoldal's goal is to display a history of Las Vegas that depicts more than political figures, and aims to highlight the more common, everyday life in the city of Las Vegas.

The materials include sheet music, advertisements, periodicals, and postcards related to Nevada. The sheet music depicts the Nevada state song, "Home Means Nevada," and other songs relevant to Nevada history throughout the late nineteenth and twentieth centuries.
