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Historical Background

The Samoset Chapter is the Las Vegas chapter of the National Society Colonial Dames XVII Century, an "organization of women who are lineal descendants of an ancestor who lived and served prior to 1701 in one of the Original Colonies in the geographical area of the present United States of

America." The Samoset Chapter was organized in 1970 and chartered in 1971. Members take part in genealogical research, support of education through various activities, and preservation of historic sites and documents.

The scrapbooks contain photographs, newspaper clippings, correspondence, and event programs. One scrapbook primarily documents the Callville Bay historic marker placement, including correspondence with the National Park Service and other state governmental bodies, photographs, and historical documentation about the original Callville Bay settlement.
